Terms and Conditions for Transportation

- 1. Customer agrees to the following terms and conditions as part of doing business with Con-Lei Transport, LLC ("Con-Lei").
- 2. Customer will be responsible for completing the Event Transportation Request Form prior to the loading of the vehicle on a Con-Lei trailer.
- 3. Customer will provide to Con-Lei a \$200 non-refundable deposit for each vehicle being transported at the time of booking. Since Con-Lei specializes in event transportation, a Customer reserves a place on a Con-Lei trailer, and that place cannot be sold to anyone else. The balance due will be paid by cash, check, credit card, or money order not less than 2 weeks prior to the loading of the vehicle on a Con-Lei trailer. Con-Lei charges a 3% handling fee on all credit card transactions. Con-Lei reserves the right to deny transportation for failure to pay balance in full (including returned checks) unless the payment is made whole by the date of departure.
- 4. Customer will provide to Con-Lei a copy of their driver's license and proof of insurance with the Event Transportation Request Form. The declared value of the vehicle being transported is the declared, insured value as represented by the Customer's personal vehicle insurance.
- 5. Customer is responsible for preparing the vehicle for transportation. All personal items are to be removed. Key is to be in the ignition. Gas tanks may contain no more than 1 gallon of fuel.
- 6. ABSOLUTELY NO ILLEGAL ITEMS WILL BE TRANSPORTED. CON-LEI RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INSPECT THE VEHICLE IF ILLEGAL ITEMS ARE SUSPECTED. THESE ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, DRUGS, DRUG PARAPHERNALIA, AND WEAPONS OF ANY KIND.

 Customer assumes any and all responsibility, legally and financially, for all actions taken against Con-Lei if Customer transports illegal items.
- 7. Customer vehicle will be loaded and unloaded onto Con-Lei trailers at predetermined times and places based upon the timing and location of the event. Con-Lei will inform Customer of these locations at the time of booking and will make available the Con-Lei event itinerary not less than 2 weeks prior to the event.
- 8. Customer will be responsible for reviewing, agreeing to, and signing off on, the Pre-Load Vehicle Inspection form. This document will report any existing damage, special features, etc. about the vehicle being transported. A dated photograph may be taken of any existing damage on the vehicle at Con-Lei's discretion. Upon arrival at the event, the Customer and Con-Lei will inspect the vehicle and Customer will sign that he/she has received the vehicle.

- 9. Con-Lei's limits of liability extend only to the transportation of Customer's vehicle while the vehicle is in Con-Lei's care. Customer assumes all risks associated with their participation in the events. Customer agrees to hold harmless Con-Lei for any and all actions by or to Customer including but not limited to, injuries or damages occurring by or to Customer, Customer's vehicle, or third party person or property directly or indirectly.
- 10. At the end of an event, Customer will return vehicle to designated loading area at a predetermined time. Customer will be responsible for reviewing, agreeing to, and signing off on, the Pre-Load Vehicle Inspection form. The same terms and conditions as stated in paragraph 8 apply.
- 11. Con-Lei is a registered motor carrier, licensed with the U.S. Department of Transportation as an Interstate Common Carrier as evidence by it's use and display of DOT #1582962 and MC #586107. Under this registration, Con-Lei is bound the rules and regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation and carries at all times, the required licenses, permits, and insurance.
- 12. Con-Lei shall not be responsible for any delay in performance which is caused by circumstances beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to any Act of God, repair shop, dealer, or anyone else.
- 13. Con-Lei assures that all information in this contract is confidential and that no information will be sold, shared, or traded with any other persons or companies.
- 14. Con-Lei reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions and shall provide the Customer thirty (30) days notice of any changes via e-mail, phone, or in writing.
- 15. If any provision or part of these terms and conditions is held to be invalid or unenforceable, all other parts remain in effect. The laws of the State of Maryland shall govern this contract. Any legal action must be filed with the District Court of Carroll County, Maryland. By executing this agreement, the Customer waives any and all rights to litigate elsewhere.
